Animals Count is a political party for people and animals. Co-founder & Chair, Jasmijn de Boo, will be contesting the Greater London Assembly Elections on 1st May in Lambeth & Southwark.

A vote for *Animals Count* means:

- Recognising that animals have interests too
- Improving animal welfare, human health and the environment
- Addressing the link between animal cruelty and domestic violence
- A chance for those who care about animals, but who have lost confidence in traditional left/right-wing political parties

Our main aims are:

1. A basic animal health care system comparable to the NHS, including subsidised veterinary treatment and emergency care
2. Healthy food provision in schools, hospitals, care homes, council premises, etc., by promoting plant-based diets and banning products from intensively farmed animals
3. Green recreation and wildlife protection through preservation and expansion of parks and green corridors
